# Alumni Mass Participants

When the St. Cecilia Development Committee was formed in 2006, a sub-committee was created soon after called the St. Cecilia School Alumni Committee. It was felt that a school alumni association would be a great addition to St. Cecilia Church. This committee was comprised of Francine DiTomaso '85, Dorothy Vinci and Bill Rahn.

St. Cecilia School opened in 1952 and closed in 1992. During that time span, the school produced over 1600 graduates in its 40 years of operation. Tracking down and reconnecting with over 1600 students continues to be a challenge to firmly establish this alumni association. Using class lists, bulletin articles, registration forms in church, and our St. Cecilia website, an alumni database was created to contain names and current contact information. Using that database, a number of mailings were done and alumni volunteers were sought. We are continuously trying to contact former alumni. As you can imagine, with many who have moved out of state, and in some cases out of the country, or discovering those who have passed on, it is an awesome task to find everyone.

On November 25th of 2006, St. Cecilia Church held its first alumni Mass and reception. Over 100 alumni, faculty, family, and friends attended the event. It was so successful that an alumni support base was formed, and by word of mouth more alumni are becoming aware of the establishment of this association.

We now have approximately 12 alumni who have stepped forward to help us make contacts. Three fall meetings were held to plan this event. At the present time we have over 600 names and current contact information.

Hopefully, tonight's 3rd annual Thanksgiving weekend reunion will help generate more interest in our alumni association, and with your help this organization will expand.
